Drug and alcohol addiction prevention programs

Around 190 thousand students have taken part in various talks, workshops and multimedia performances which have been organized for 10 years by Leszek Korzeniecki – an addiction treatment therapy instructor working for the Voice of the Gospel Foundation. The meetings are held within the framework of the project “Youth without drugs” and performances “Live outside a cage”.

THE MEDIA

Evangelization and promotion of evangelical values



For over 45 years, through 42 radio stations which broadcast our radio documentaries, we have been telling stories about the people whose lives have been changed by God. Our documentaries reach over 280 cities and towns. At least 140 thousand Polish people listen to us every week. Since 2004 we have been making TV documentaries – “Transformations” (TVP1) and animated movies – “Stupid-wise movie” (RELIGIA TV).



PRISONS

Evangelization through internal broadcasting systems

We regularly deliver our radio documentaries to 139 out of 165 Polish prisons and custody suites. The prisoners staying in their cells can listen to the Gospel about just and loving God who is able to give them real freedom. They can also hear our Christian audiobooks with many real stories of those who have decided to repent.

EVANGELIZATION AND CHRISTIAN EDUCATION OF YOUTH



Youth camps with participation of young people who are poor and disabled

Over 2600 teenagers from different parts of Poland have already taken part in our youth camps we have been organizing for 20 years. Each year – thanks to the support of our partners, donors and volunteers - we can show our Christian love and care to young people coming from pathological families, orphanages and poor backgrounds. During the camps most of them can hear the Good News about Jesus Christ, the Hope that never fails, for the first time.

SUPPORT FOR EVANGELIZATION INITIATIVES OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITIES



Every year the President of The Voice of the Gospel Foundation - an evangelist Henryk Dedo – preaches during a number of outreaches organized by Polish local Christian communities. His evangelical message, encouraging us to confront and reconcile with God, has already softened lots of hearts. Henryk also carries out evangelization workshops “Tell the world about Jesus”.

THE YEAR OF CRISIS?



It is just natural for each of us that we try to find ourselves in a place or situation in which we might feel safe. Unfortunately, the world we live in is the place which brings more and more uncertainty and threats. Our life resembles a journey in a small boat which has to struggle with huge waves. We try to pour water out of the boat in all the possible ways.

Finally, extremely tired and exhausted we remember the name of Jesus. He seems to be present in our boat sailing through the troubled waters of life – but we think that he must be asleep.

We start calling him full of sorrow and grudge. Just like His disciples did. And when we finally – as we think – wake Him up from sleep with our call, what do we really expect from Him? **Most frequently we are just willing to give Him another bucket to help us pour the water out of the boat. We easily forget that He is the One to whom all the power is given in heaven and on earth.**

What do we need in such situations? Helplessness, honesty, trust – the features typical of a child who has a chance and a privilege to have a loving, wise, good, reliable dad. This Best Father is waiting for the moment when I come to Him with confidence, helplessness and honesty of a child who knows that is loved is really His child.

I remember when one day, during a pre-Christmas meeting held in one of radio stations, a bishop who was present there said: 'Dear Ladies and Gentlemen, a truly unpredictable year lies ahead'. When I was giving the bishop my best wishes I told him that what he had just said was true – there was however one thing I added – **that fortunately Jesus is very predictable in that so unpredictable future.**

I wish we could remember about this truth when we are on the eve of the New Year bombarded with more and more terrifying information.

No – the road to that first Christmas was a rocky one. And that's what makes Christmas real for me. Not some nice, soft, little fluffy kid's pantomime. Christmas is life. Real life. Jesus.

Impressive Radio Technique – another success of Waldemar Kasperczak

On 16 November in the Władysław Szpilman Concert Studio at the headquarters of Polish Radio there was a solemn announcement of the results of one of the most prestigious Polish contests in the field of documentaries – Grand Prix of the National Radio and Television Council.

The jury of the contest awarded the first prize to Patrycja Gruszyńska-Ruman for “showing with great sensitivity and culture a not well-known fact from the most recent history and impressive radio technique”.

Her documentary titled: *I will come back when I don't need the sun any longer* tells the story of Emil Barchański, a student of Mikołaj Rej Secondary School in Warszawa, one of the youngest oppositionist, who died in 1982 under unknown circumstances.

We are proud of our former colleague and of the fact that the winning documentary was produced by **Waldemar Kasperczak from the studio of the Voice of the Gospel Foundation.**

Evangelization and Christian Education of Young People

On 19 January 2012 in the centre of the Christ Baptist Church in Krynica-Zdrój we are organizing a training conference for tutors and organizers of the summer



youth camp Dymin 2012. The tutors will be able to find out something about the program of the activities to be carried out during the camp and they will also work on other organizational issues. Evangelization and Christian Education of Youth Dymin 2011 'Freestyle'

Over 20 years ago we started organizing summer and winter youth camps implementing innovation programme combining sports and artistic classes with Bible study.

Thanks to generosity and support of individual benefactors and Christian organizations from abroad we can invite to our camps young people from poor families, pathological families and children's homes designated by local Churches and Christian charity organizations. 40 such teenagers participated in this year's summer camp, whereas there were over 120 participants in total. Apart from a comprehensive sports program, access to a lake and a number of interesting hobby workshops conducted by aficionados and professionals, including crafts and arts workshops, astronomy workshops, workshops on philosophy, photography, music, ornithology and paintball – the participants took part in Bible study, philosophical debates, movie evenings and worship concerts.

As for the subject, the camp focused on freedom and our guests, who shared the Word of God and their experiences – very often very painful – with the young participants included:

Anna Kułakowska (an addiction prevention specialist, the Manager of the Re-adaptation Centre for Addicts and Socially Unadapted People in Świdnica – a branch of the Christian Charity Association in Klucze); Leszek Korzeniowski (an addiction prevention specialist working for the Voice of the Gospel Foundation); Janusz Kucharczyk PhD (a philosopher, a classical philologist, a lecturer at the University of Silesia and Higher Baptist Theological Seminary in Warszawa); Mateusz Otremba (a Christian artist /Mate.O/); Mateusz Wichary (Chief Editor of the monthly "Słowo Prawdy"; a Practical Theology lecturer at Higher Baptist Theological Seminary in Warszawa).

The camps organized by the Voice of the Gospel Foundation do not concentrate exclusively on the Gospel. I would rather focus on less spiritual and more secular or trivial aspects of the camps, which I think are equally important. Kids often get into trouble because of too much time, lack of interesting and useful activities, bad company. At the camps children can spend their holiday time in a constructive way, in good company, taking part in fun and games and avoiding the risk of access to drugs, alcohol or unwanted pregnancy. The camps offer alternative ways of spending free time, they may instill sports, artistic or scientific passions in young people. They show that there are other people and priorities than just drug dealers or participants of boozy parties or sexual experiments. Sometimes this is enough to show teenagers that Christianity is not just cliché, the smell of incense, empty tradition and moralizing but great fun and an exciting challenge.

We would like to express our gratitude towards all the tutors who were willing to devote their time and effort, free of charge, and took part in various sports activities and fun and games and tried to keep pace with the teenagers, which often resulted in overstraining – and towards all the volunteers who were responsible for various events which took place during the camp.

A few thoughts from the camp participants:



Never before have I wondered what real freedom is. I found it in my relationship with God which actually started here...at the camp.

I came to the camp feeling depressed and drained. During biblical lectures I realized that the sadness I was filled with was the result of my rebellion. I am coming back home full of hope and thankfulness in my heart. I am going to share the joy of being reunited with God with my friends.

When I was going to the camp I did not expect that something unusual might happen there. Yet, lots of amazing things happened there. It was a great time. In every respect.



I want to continue my life in obedience to God. I have dreams. I have a Friend. I know that I can trust Him and he will never disappoint me.

I am a bit worried about what will happen to me when I have to leave my children's home. I don't know where I will live. Orphanages have very little money for the children who are brought up there. At the camp I understood that God knows my situation and He will take care of everything.

This was the first time I had heard that someone loved me. It was the first time I had felt accepted and understood. Selflessly. This is the most important. Life with God makes sense.

coOPERATION Project

Since the time the Foundation was established we have been deeply convinced that it is necessary to take action for and having in view the Kingdom of God. Therefore we have been supporting various initiatives of Christian Communities and organizations for many years and in different ways, depending on the circumstances and our abilities – especially in the early stages of their development.

Because we still want to break the common belief that only these things and issues which consider us personally are the most significant – we launched our “coOperation” project in February this year. Kasia Błędowska - who used to be a volunteer and a tutor at summer and winter youth camps organized by the Voice of the Gospel Foundation – is the coordinator of the project.

We would like to present a short summary of what we have already achieved and our plans for the future.

In June we finished shooting a film titled: “Life is a Gift” made for the Jesus Christ Security Foundation. The Foundation runs support centres for addicted and homeless people, it has 6 branches in different areas of Poland. “Life is a Gift” is a film used by the Foundation as a promotional tool - we attached it to the December issue of the monthly magazine Słowo i Życie.

Within the framework of “coOperation” we also shoot a promotional film titled: “The House of Lazarus” telling about the fruits of the work of the centre run by the Bethlehem Charity Association in Kraków. This is a place where homeless people may find shelter and comprehensive assistance. Special care and attention is provided to older people who frequently live out their days in the House of Lazarus. You can read some testimonies confirming God’s blessing over the place in our brochure titled: “Not quite a usual story”.

At present we are preparing an exhibition dedicated to the issue of homelessness. It aims at showing people how serious the problem is in Poland and at

encouraging others to provide their help and support.

The exhibition will be mobile, which will enable us to show it many times in various places.

We are also preparing to start working on a film promoting the activity of the Factory of Smile Youth Club run by Joanna Tomanek. The Youth Club is located in the worst district of Myslowice called “Rymera”. The subjects of the Factory of Smile Youth Club were our guests at the summer youth camp Dymin “Freestyle” 2011.

Within the framework of the coOperation project we support more and more Christian charity organizations. The project will cover, among other organizations: Teen Challenge Christian Mission, New Beginning – a Centre for the Homeless, Chance – Social Therapeutic Centre attached to the Parish of Evangelical Church of the Augsburg Confession in Zabrze.

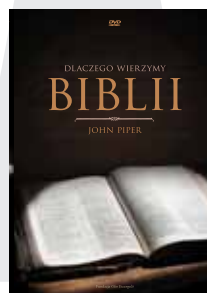


The End of the Spear Director: Jim Hanon
